- WAX IT: WAXING YOUR HOOD IS RECOMMENDED TO BE DONE AT LEAST EVERY 4 OR 5 MONTHS DEPENDING ON HOW MUCH YOU COOK IF YOU HAVE SIGNIFICANT STAINS FOLLOW STEPS ON THE NEXT PAGES,
- ENSURE TO STORE POTENTIALLY
 DESTRUCTIVE OBJECTS SUCH AS
 KNIVES, HAMMERS, POWER TOOLS, OR
 ANY OTHER ITEMS THAT COULD
 POTENTIALLY HARM YOUR RANGE

Use a clean soft cloth to remove the dust from the hood, use an air duster if necessary.

Take another clean soft cloth and using just a little bit of mild soap and water go over the areas you need to clean. Make sure the water/soap stays away from other metals like Copper, Brass or Stainless Steel.

With another clean rag dry your hood and make sure to fully remove water and soap off of your range hood.




Use a clean soft cloth to remove the dust from the hood, use an air duster if necessary. Nothing else needs to be done to clean your range hood.

If necessary, to remove grease or stains keep following steps below

Using your Scotch brite pad, softly go over the area you want to clean making the movement with your hand according to the finish you have on the metals, see pictures below for reference.

Repeat step 1, with another clean rag remove the dust from the hood, use an air duster if necessary.


Seal the area applying your renaissance wax polish with another clean rag, think of it like waxing your shoes.

STAINLESS STEEL



Use a clean soft cloth to remove the dust from the hood, use an air duster if necessary. Nothing else needs to be done to clean your range hood patina finish.

If necessary, to remove grease or stains: Using your Scotch brite pad, softly go over the area you want to clean making the movement with your hand according to the finish you have on the metals, see pictures below for reference.



MATTE FIINISH LINEAR BRUSHED FINISH

Apply 2 to 3 sprays of the stainless-steel polish on your clean rag (do not apply stainless steel polish directly on your hood) and softly go over the area you want to clean. No wax is needed.

Note: Stainless Steel polish we recommend is oil based, and you will probably have to go all over the body of your hood to make it even.

Use a clean soft cloth to remove the dust from the hood, use an air duster if necessary.

Use your polish rag, and go over the range hood mirror finish, just like polishing a shoe. nothing else needs to be done after this step.







Use a clean soft cloth to remove the dust from the hood, use an air duster if necessary nothing else needs to be done to clean your range hood patina finish.

If there are minor stains from finger prints, grease, etc.:

Using your Scotch brite pad, softly go over the area you want to clean making the movement with your hand according to the finish you have on the metals, see pictures below for reference.





CLOUDY LINEAR BRUSHED FINISH





Again, Use a clean soft cloth to remove the dust and excess of patina from the hood use an air duster if necessary.

WAX IT: Waxing your hood is recommended to be done at least every 4 or 5 months depending on how much you cook.

To begin, grab a fresh and gentle cloth (avoid using the one you used to remove the dust).

Apply wax to this cloth. Before you start waxing your hood, keep in mind that it is best to apply the wax across the entire range hood. This will ensure a smooth and even finish.

Now, take your clean cloth with the wax and gently go over the range hood, just like polishing a shoe. Remember, it's important to buff the wax quickly. If you let it sit on the metal for too long, it will dry and become difficult to buff. By following these steps, you'll have a beautifully waxed range hood in no time!

SCRATCHES AND MAJOR STAINS

If you notice a significant scratch or stain on your range hood, it's best not to attempt any DIY fixes. Instead, we suggest reaching out to your reliable metal fabricator or contractor who can offer appropriate solutions. Don't hesitate to contact us if you have any queries or concerns – we're here to assist you and guide you through the next steps in repairing your range hood.


